John also explains how disruptive technologies in food like Foodini a 3D Food printer, Amazon food fresh and Blue Apron can affect the way we do business; learning how other companies are keeping up with demand and using current data can be a very valuable resource of information. Not only can we learn from these new technologies but we can introduce new markets with value added products and innovation. Now is the time businesses owners have to stay in touch with future trends and continually keep up with meeting consumers needs!


Opportunities in West Prince for growth in the aquaculture industry, oysters, shellfish species and land based finfish. Other opportunities included wagyu beef (Chinese market), cheese, blueberries and apples.

Potatoes still remain dominant in West Prince 2011-2016 with a slight increase. and many opportunities exist with growth in malt barley and pulses. WA Grains & Pulse Solutions in Summerside specialize in growing pulses (faba beans/green & yellow peas). The demand is strong and crop has a low environmental footprint. They are one of the fastest growing companies in Canada and owned by a former Islander.

Lobster remains dominant with 50% of all PEI landings from Western PEI; \$100M landed value in 2016 and Snow crab, herring, rock crab also very important the economic growth.

John also spoke on the importance of the Regional Economic Advisory Councils and how their mission is to help guide, develop and help drive community and economic growth across Island communities to ensure prosperity for all.
